The Nobu Hotel Ibiza Bay is opening in June.

Nobu Hospitality will open a hotel on the Spanish island Ibiza in June, and plans to break ground on its first Canada hotel in Toronto next year.

The Nobu Hotel Ibiza Bay will sit on a Talamanca Bay beachfront and will include Ibiza's first Six Senses-branded spa. The 152-room hotel will feature abundant natural wood in its guestrooms and will have a color scheme featuring whites, golds and blues. The property will also have three restaurants, include a Nobu restaurant.

The Nobu Hotel Toronto will be part of the redevelopment of the Pilkington Glass Factory.

Two new 49-story towers will complement the current building's historic façade. The hotel's suites will be atop one of the towers. The project will include 700 condominiums, ground-floor retail and a Nobu restaurant.
